Monetary donations to support the program are also needed and appreciated!
- Please drop off baskets at the GOLD office, or at Fowler Insurance at 11042 Nicholas Lane in Ocean Pines during their business hours (M-F, 9am to 5pm) by Friday, March 30, 2017. Fowler Insurance prefers that their office not be called ahead of time.
- We have far more children on the list than we have sponsors, so if you have the resources, please consider creating modest baskets for more children, rather than fewer, more elaborate baskets. Our goal this year is for every child to have a sponsor!
- Suggestions for filling the baskets include individually wrapped candy and healthy snacks, toothbrush and toothpaste, coloring book & crayons, stickers, barrettes, comb and brush, small toys, socks, lotion, shampoo or other hygiene items, notepads, pens and pencils. We ask that you do not include cash, since it is not always used in the best interest of the child. Baskets should be securely wrapped in cellophane or a clear plastic bag.
